Kandice Kidd took the information to heart and when she got home she began working. She got her church family involved by asking for funds to gather blanket material and for participation their in this activity. She challenged them with the burden she had to provide blankets for children in need.

When the day to make the blankets arrived, Kidd and 75 other people from her community began tying together all the blankets. Kidd said "Even my Papa got on his hands and knees to make them."

That Friday evening was filled with laughter and fellowship as they spent time together in order to make difference for someone halfway across the world.

Kandice Kidd took her passion for hanging out with friends and family and combined that with her burden to see children in Zambia have a warm blanket. The result was 65 fleece tie blankets made for children in Zambia.
